New Feature in Archers Diary

Paul Korosi from Paringa Archers (who wrote Archers Diary) has been working on a couple of online features for Archers Diary.

He has recently created a Members Portal as part of Archers Diary and is now available to members. It allows you to see all your Club and Competition shoots, keep track of your Bow Setup & Arrows setups, create practice rounds and score them, assign a bow and arrow set to each round you shoot.

You will need to register first with your email address and your Membership Number that is in Archers Diary (Which is your Assemble Membership Number) and create a password, you will get a verification back via your email address.

Once you have logged in you can see the events you have registered for in Archers Diary, You can also edit these registrations as well.

At the top of the screen you can see some tabs the accounts tab just shows you info.

The Diary Tab shows a calendar with the events you have scored for and by click on a date will show what event that was.

The Assets tab allows you add information about your Bows & sets of Arrows as a record of your setup. There is also Practice Target Rounds so you can create your own rounds to enable you to score practice sessions.

The Events Tab has a list of your Competitions Events (The Events you have entered via Archers Diary) A list of your Practice Sessions, Your Best Scores, Handicaps and what score.

The List of Competitions allow you to look at all your Club shoots & Competition events. You can see the event by clicking on the name and it will open Archers Diary to that event.

In your list if you click on the score for an event, it will display your scorecard.

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You can also add the bow & arrows you used by clicking on the three dots and selecting edit.

If you click on the three dots and select Scoring it will again show you your scorecard.

The List of Practice session is much the same as the Competitions except that once the Session is created you can score it either by manually adding the scores or using the virtual target by placing each arrow on the target face and it calculates the score.

The Best Scores, Handicaps & What Score are all drop down options to display results.

Also

In addition to the Members portal, there is a Coaches Portal, which allows coaches to keep track of where they have provided coaching to groups or individuals. This includes Come and Try events. This record will. Help keep track of how much coaching you have been involved in when it comes time to re accredit.
